Adding the suffix -ment turns a verb into a noun.

enjoyment payment

-ment can usually be added straight to the root word.

-ness

Adding the suffix -ness to an adjective turns it into a noun.

softness thickness

If the root word ends in **y**, you need to replace the **y** with an **i** and then add the suffix.

happy tidy happiness tidiness


